- The College diploma pathway prepares students for entrance to a four-year Louisiana state university or for a career. The Jump Start pathway prepares them for a Louisiana state community college, technical school, or entrance into the workforce.
- Before a student can change their diploma pathway, the student, the student's parent/guardian/custodian, and the school counselor shall meet to discuss the student's progress and determine what is in the student's best interest for the continuation of his/her educational pursuit and future educational plan.

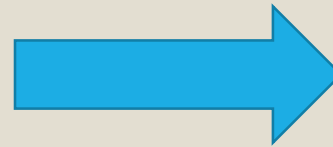

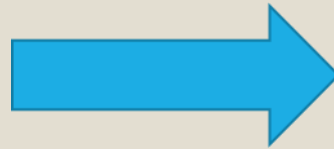

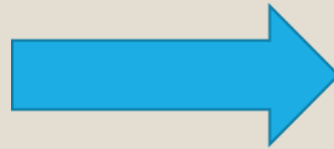

After the student has attended high school for a minimum of two years, the student and the student's parent, guardian, or custodian may request that the student exits the TOPS University Diploma pathway and enter the Jump Start TOPS Tech Diploma pathway.

The TOPS University Diploma pathway prepares students for entrance to a four-year Louisiana state university or for a career. The Jump Start TOPS Tech Diploma pathway would prepare them for a Louisiana state community college or technical school or entrance into the workforce.

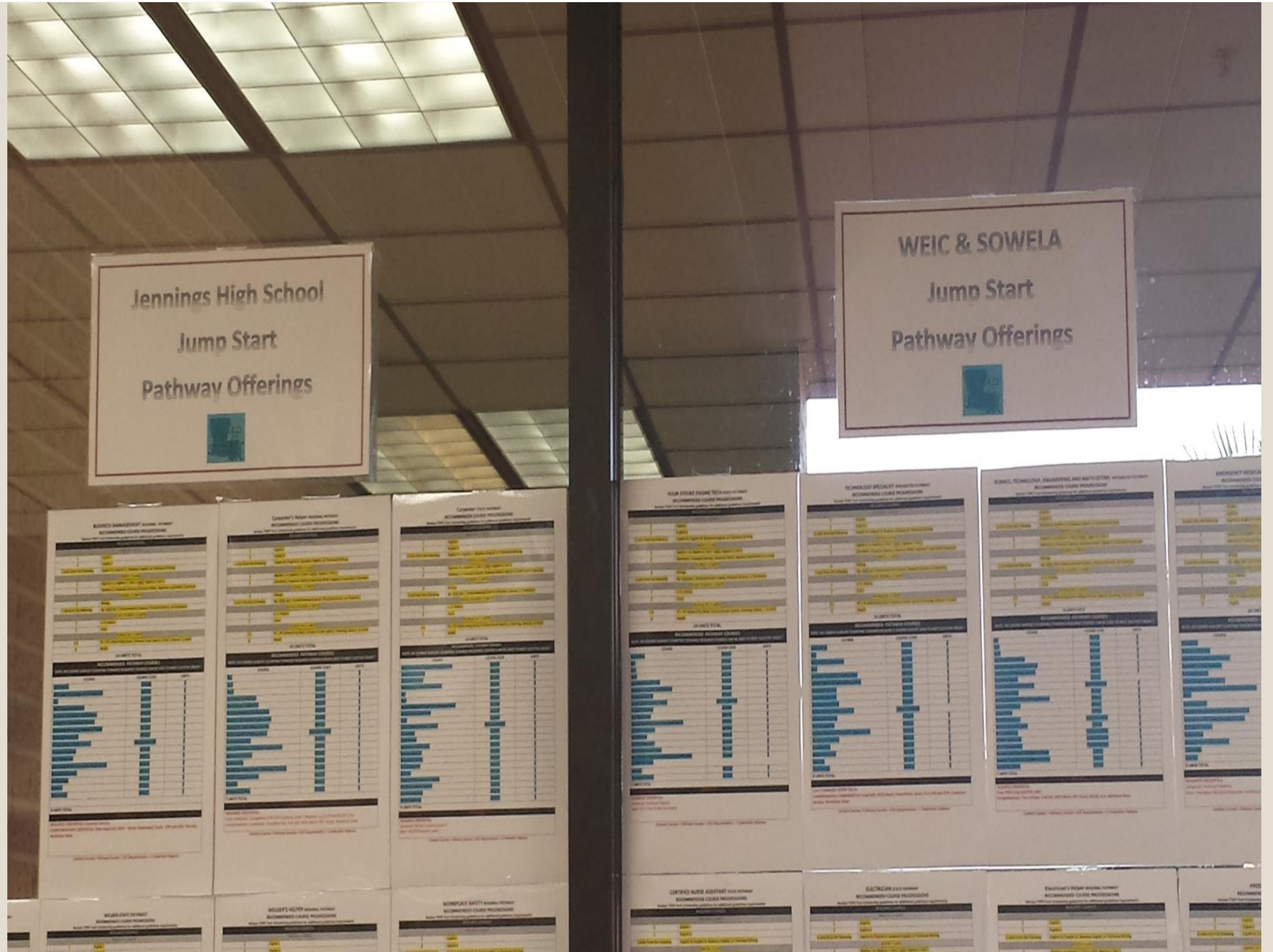
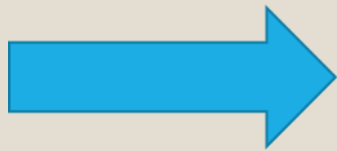

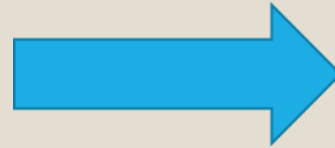
